The Banco courtroom holds approx. 200 people but for Covid safety it recommends that one seat be left in between each person unless you are couples or families – that means approx. 100 would be the safest and this also allows for seating for others as well. Attendees must be respectful. Phones are to be turned off (not on silent), there is to be no noise or comments during the proceedings and we request that your attire is neat and tidy (no hats). When the Judges enter the courtroom we all stand and bow and a similar process when they leave the room – you can follow what the barristers and lawyers do.
